



Helias Catholic High School **STUDENT ACCOMMODATIONS PROGRAM**

At Helias Catholic, we value the whole student — mind, body and soul. The Accommodations Program works with a variety of students who have physical, medical and/or diagnosed learning differences to support them in the classroom as well as promote self-advocacy skills. By creating an open line of communication and building positive relationships between students, families and teachers, we hope to provide a learning environment to help all Helias Catholic students thrive.

Process to Request Accommodations:

- All psycho-educational evaluations, medical documentation and documentation supporting the need for accommodations must be submitted during time of enrollment.
- Based on the documentation received, Helias Catholic will determine if accommodations are warranted.

Documentation Required:

- **CURRENT** IEP/Service Plan or Accommodation Plan in place.
 - Includes dates, evaluation assessments and results used to determine diagnosis.
 - Lists recommended accommodations currently in place.
- Relevant medical diagnosis from a medical professional or psychological evaluator.
 - Diagnosed or reconfirmed within the last three years.
 - Includes professional credentials and signature of the evaluator.

Accommodations are specific to each individual student. They will be provided and implemented by school personnel to the best of our ability. Any questions and concerns should be directed to the accommodations coordinator.

The Diocese of Jefferson City does not recognize 504 plans. Families of students who are currently on a 504 plan should set up a meeting with the accommodations coordinator to review supports and accommodations that can be put in place.

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
